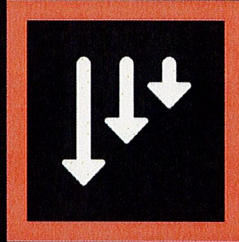

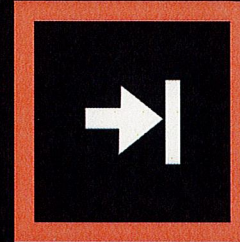
REQUIRE DE-ESCALATION

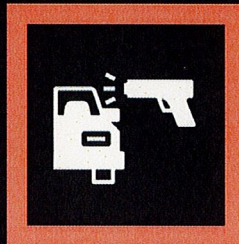

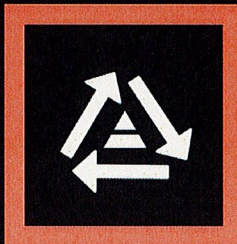
DUTY TO INTERVENE
