The City of Berkeley, Public Works Department, will be upgrading the infrastructures at the intersection of Ninth Street and Ashby Avenue in your neighborhood. This work is funded by Caltrans Active Transportation Program (ATP) and Alameda County Measure F Vehicle Registration Fee Program. Redgwick Construction Company has contracted with the City of Berkeley to perform work at the intersection of Ninth Street and Ashby Avenue. The work involves the construction of a new pedestrian and bicycle pathway, traffic signal, site furnishings, curb ramps, sidewalk, traffic striping, and landscaping.

Construction work will take place Monday to Friday between 7:30 AM – 4:30 PM. Please be aware of changing traffic conditions due to lane closures/reductions and temporary “No-Parking” signs at various locations. Access to driveways, parking lots and businesses will be maintained with intermittent interruption due to construction. Pedestrian curb ramps will be impacted and detour routes will be implemented. No holiday work is anticipated.
