

**PUBLIC NOTICE
STREET REHABILITATION PROJECT**

The City of Berkeley, Public Works Department, will be rehabilitating the street pavement in your neighborhood with a surface seal.

LOCATION: 8th, 9th, Allston, Avenida, Berryman, Bret Harte, Campus, Cornell, Cragmont, Delaware, Euclid, Florida, Hearst, Jones, Josephine, Page, Parker, San Pedro, Solano, Solano Tunnel, Somerset Pl, Sonoma, Southampton, Spruce, The Alameda, The Circle, Vassar, Vincente, Whitney, and Woolsey. *See location map on backside.*

TIMELINE: Construction is expected to begin in May/June 2017 and take about six months to complete depending on weather or unforeseen conditions. Construction in your immediate vicinity may not extend for this entire period.

Standard work hours are 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Monday - Friday

POSSIBLE INCONVENIENCES: Traffic will be delayed at the work site and street closures may be necessary but will not exceed 12 hours at a time. "No Parking" signs will be posted along the street 3 days in advance and will be enforced. Please see the posted signs for exact hours and locations. All other usual parking restrictions, including no parking for street cleaning, will still be in effect. Access to private driveways may be prohibited during some operations. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

PROPERTY OWNER AND RESIDENT ACTIONS:

- Sensitive to Petroleum: Be aware that asphalt will be used in this project
- Avoiding Oil Spray: Park your vehicles outside of the construction area. Oil and asphalt are not easily removed from shoes, floors and rugs
- Safety: Keep children and pets away from work area
- Property owners are responsible for trimming their trees and vegetation growing into the roadway, and for installation and maintenance of water barriers (against runoff) with a minimum height of 6 inches.
- Any permits issued for use of the right-of-way are temporarily suspended, in accordance with BMC 16.16.050, while the work takes place. Contact City for coordination of critical work
