Dear Valued Customer,

At Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) our top priority is to provide you with safe, reliable, affordable and clean energy. As part of our continued commitment to ensure reliability and safety, we will be modernizing our electric lines and equipment by upgrading underground electrical equipment in your community.

This work will take place in the vicinity of University Avenue between McGee Avenue and Martin Luther King Jr Way in Berkeley. We expect work to start in mid-December and continue through May 2019. Weather and other factors that affect safe working conditions may change our schedule.

What you can expect

All personnel are required to carry valid photo identification and are happy to provide it upon request. During construction, you may see PG&E, contractor trucks and other heavy equipment. We will do our best to minimize the impact, but you may hear intermittent construction noise.

We expect most work to take place during business hours Monday through Friday. We planned ahead to avoid electric service interruption during construction. However, if a temporary service interruption is necessary, we will send a separate letter in advance to provide you with the details and schedule of the interruption in service.

Potential traffic impacts

If necessary, we will post "No Parking" signs at least 72 hours in advance of the work and route traffic around work areas. Driveway access may be affected, but crews can provide access within a few minutes of a request. Please plan for minor delays if crews are working outside your home or business.
