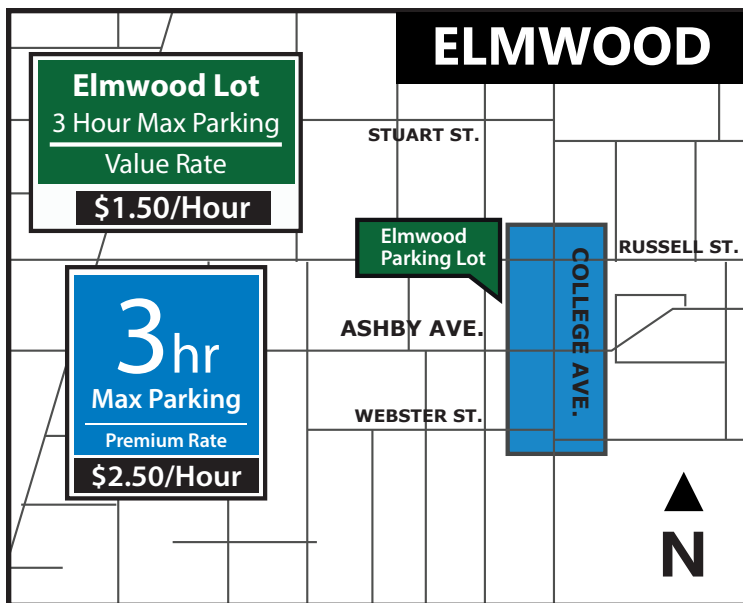
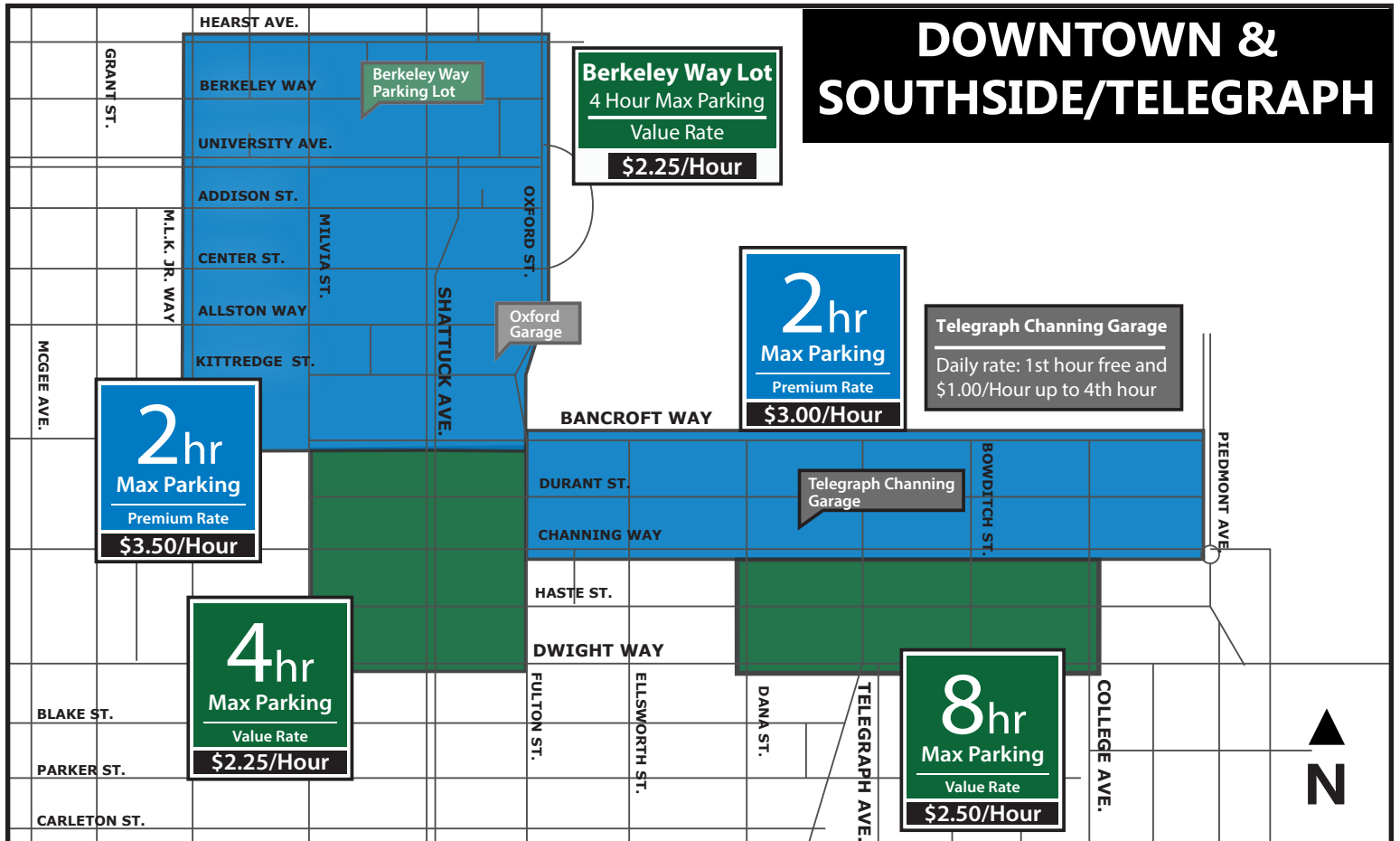

What is goBerkeley?

goBerkeley is a City of Berkeley program that improves the safety and ease of travel in three of Berkeley's vibrant commercial districts: Downtown, Southside/Telegraph, and the Elmwood, through better parking management practices.

Using a data driven approach, goBerkeley works by periodically adjusting parking rates, based on user demand, to achieve 1-2 open spaces per blockface¹. More parking availability means less circling, more time at your destination, cleaner air, and safer streets for all.

¹ Blockface - one side of one block, e.g., the north side of Center Street between Milvia Street and Shattuck Avenue.
