



# COVID-19 Parking information

*Last updated July 16, 2021*

## Parking Meter Rates

Berkeley resumed enforcement for parking meters on July 1, 2020. Meters are set to a minimum of \$0.50 per hour citywide. Meter rates are higher in high-demand areas.

Rates as of July 21, 2021 are as follows:

### \$1.00/hour parking areas:

- San Pablo Ave: 2000 block & 2500 block (2-hour meters)
- San Pablo Ave: 1200-1800 blocks

### \$1.25/hour parking areas:

- Euclid/Hearst (Northside) commercial district

### \$1.50/hour parking areas:

- Alta Bates Hospital area
- 4<sup>th</sup> Street: Hearst Ave to University Ave
- Shattuck Ave from Dwight Way to Carleton St
- Solano commercial district (all other streets/blocks than listed under \$2.00)
- Telegraph Ave: Dwight Way to Woolsey St

### \$2.00/hour parking areas:

- Alcatraz Ave/College Ave commercial district
- Claremont commercial district: 2900 Claremont, 2900 Domingo, 3000 Ashby
- Elmwood Parking Lot
- North Shattuck: Shattuck Ave from Rose St to Hearst Ave and side streets
- Solano commercial district (1700-1800 Solano & 900 Colusa)

### \$2.25/hour parking areas:

- Southside/Telegraph 8-hour zone

### \$2.50/hour parking areas:

- 4<sup>th</sup> Street: Virginia St to Hearst Ave & 700 block of Hearst Ave
- Downtown Berkeley 8-hour zone: Shattuck Ave from Bancroft Way to Dwight Way and side streets
- Elmwood commercial district: 2800-3000 College Ave and side streets
- Southside/Telegraph 2-hour zone: Telegraph Ave from Bancroft Way to Dwight Way and side streets

\$3.50/hour parking areas:

- Downtown Berkeley 2-hour zone: Shattuck Ave from Hearst Ave to Bancroft Way and side streets

## Parking Garages

The Telegraph Channing garage (2450 Durant) and Center Street garage (2025 Center) are open for off-street parking with reduced hours (closing at 10pm).

Effective August 1, 2021, the Center Street Garage will close at 11:30pm.

The Oxford garage (2165 Kittredge) is closed.
