The Berkeley Rent Stabilization Board will hold a public hearing at its regular monthly meeting on Monday, May 15, 2017. The purpose of this public hearing is to consider whether to increase the Board's annual registration fee due July 3, 2017, by an amount not to exceed \$41.00 per unit, to offset increases in cost-of-living, fringe benefits, non-personnel costs, and the capital expenditure necessary to upgrade the agency's public information database and provide increased online access to the public. While the yearly registration fee may be increased by a maximum of \$41.00, the Board may choose not to increase it or may vote to increase it by a lesser amount.

The Board encourages the public to participate in this hearing. During Public Forum, individuals are allotted three minutes to speak and representatives of organizations are allotted five minutes to speak.

This hearing, like all Rent Board meetings held in Council Chambers, may be viewed on BTV Cable Channel 33 or via live webcast at www.cityofberkeley.info/rent and will also be broadcast live on KPFB – 89.3. Council Chambers is wheelchair-accessible.
